

## **Market access and the advantages of central location**

Central Hesse is strategically located in the very heart of Germany.

Approximately 15.8 million people live within a two-hour radius of one another. Germany's and Europe's most important urban and industrial centres are quickly and easily accessible, thanks to Central Hesse's prime location and the excellent connections to the national motorway and railway networks. One quarter of Germany's major corporations can be reached within two hours. The excellent regional roads and rail network guarantees short distances and minimal travel time. In fact, the average time needed to reach the nearest Autobahn onramp is only 15 minutes. Limburg ICE Train Station and the close proximity to Frankfurt Int'l Airport, continental Europe's largest and busiest airport, round off the region's superb infrastructure.

Frankfurt Int'l Airport can be reached in an average of 45 minutes. Moreover, it is only 19 minutes by train from the Limburg ICE Train Station.

The region's excellent long-distance transport connections provide easy access:

- To the Autobahn network (A 3, A 5, A 45, A 480 incl. B 3, B 49, B 54/B 417 and B62)
- To the railway network (ICE station Limburg and Fulda, IC stations Giessen and Marburg)
- To the airports Frankfurt Rhine-Main, Frankfurt (Hahn), Siegerland and Kassel-Calden
